i-Vote terms and conditions

The Miss Universe New Zealand 2015 winner will be named during a live Grand Final show at SKYCITY Theatre on October 24, 2015. Online voting details and criteria are below. I-Vote details and criteria can be found at nextmissnz.com.

The public vote will count towards 50% of the final scores for the 20 contenders. This will be overseen by an independent adjudicator. The remaining 50% will be from the Judges' scores on the night.

In the unlikely event of a tie in the public vote amongst the two contenders obtaining the highest number of votes, the award will be shared amongst those two. There will be no award in second place category and the third place category award will go to the contender scoring highest after the two in the tie.

Voting terms and conditions

1. Voting will be from a shortlist of 20 contenders. Each contender will be issued with a webpage at iticket.co.nz for Vote Bundle purchases. There is no voting via email, SMS, or by phone. The voting instructions will be posted on the Miss Universe New Zealand website.
2. Voters can vote online. In order to vote you will need to purchase an i-vote voting bundle from iticket.co.nz. The basic vote bundle is charged at NZ\$5 and will count as 5 votes for the contender selected. A dollar (NZ\$1) from each bundle goes to Variety, the Children's Charity. Payment is by credit or debit card.
3. Online votes will be limited to 200 bundles at NZ\$5 per bundle, per payment card/email address. Any votes over this limit will not be counted, but you will still be charged.
4. The online vote will be open till October 24, 2015 at 8.30 p.m. NZDT.
5. If you are watching Miss Universe New Zealand online, following through a website or any other time shift or catch-up service you should not vote since the vote will have closed but you will still be charged.
6. You must obtain the bill payer's permission before voting.
7. Please be sure you carefully select the name of the contender you wish to vote for prior to purchase and have selected the correct contender.
8. Miss Universe New Zealand reserves the right to disqualify votes if it has reasonable grounds to suspect that fraudulent, excessive or suspicious patterns of voting have occurred or if it considers there has been any attempt to rig the voting.
9. All voting will be overseen by an independent verification service.
10. Miss Universe New Zealand reserves the right to cancel or suspend voting at any time. In the event of any such cancellation or suspension, a technical failure or any other malfunction with the vote, Miss Universe New Zealand reserves the right to arrange for the winner to be decided using a vote count taken at the time of cancellation or suspension.
